**P/38/25 Apologies For Absence**

Apologies were received from Cllr Bicknell, Cllr Black and Cllr Williamson.

**P/41/25 To Approve Minutes of the Meeting held on 16 June 2025**

The minutes of the meeting on 16 June 2025 were presented for approval.

**Resolved: to adopt the minutes of the meeting of the Property, Highways and Environment Committee held on 16 June 2025.**

**P/42/25 Matters arising from the previous minutes** - None

**P/43/25 To organise a review of the Council input to WSCC Winter Offer Agreement – submission closing date 24<sup>th</sup> October 2025**

A review of previous arrangements and proposals for 2025/2026 would be prepared for the October Council meeting. **ACTION: Clerk** to check contractual and other arrangements for the Parish Council paying for additional road clearing in the event of heavy snow.

**ACTION: Clerk** to circulate proposed update of Parish Council Winter plan for 2025/2026, and the WSCC 2025/2026 information, to Councillors for review, including a spreadsheet allocating responsibility for checking grit bins through the winter period.

**ACTION: Cllr Jenkins** to confirm name of local farmer carrying out road clearance on behalf of WSCC. **ACTION: Clerk** to circulate WSCC advice note on applying grit.

**P/44/25 To consider any requirement for additional works on Parish Council trees**

A request had been received from the Horticultural Society for the Parish Council to fund the removal of two dead hawthorn trees to the rear of the wildflower area on the junction of The Leys and Vann Road. A quote from a tree surgeon for £250 exc VAT to carry out the work had also been received.

**RESOLVED: Cllr Buchanan to remove the two dead trees voluntarily on behalf of the Horticultural Society.**

**ACTION: Clerk** to contact householder regarding the large dead ash tree in the hedge alongside the grass area at the junction of Hogs Hill and the A286.

**ACTION: Clerk** to obtain quotes for the crown lifting of the Parish Council plane tree at the village green.

**ACTION: Clerk** to contact WSCC to request repairs to be carried out of the pavement: (1) on Vann Road; (2) by the A286 by the Youth Club access; and (3) by the A286 at the crossroads by the traffic lights.

**P/45/25 To consider ongoing concerns with road safety in the Parish**

**ACTION: Clerk** to repeat request to WSCC to repair the collapsing ditch along Vann Road at Van Common.

**ACTION: Clerk** to contact Lynchmere Parish Council regarding joint application for a reduction in the speed limit of Vann Road to 40mph.

**P/46/25 To consider carrying out annual maintenance of the war memorial**

*Cllr Inns declared an interest as a member of the Parochial Church Council and elected not to take part in the discussion or decision on this item.*

The recent grant application to the War Memorial Trust had been refused. The War Memorial Trust also recommended that the Parish Council introduce a regular maintenance regime of gentle hand cleaning of the stone annually to avoid stubborn/unremovable deposits building up on the stonework. **ACTION: Clerk** to discuss annual cleaning of the war memorial with the Village Ranger.

**P/47/25 To consider value of establishing a Council Lead for the Burial Ground, including inspection of gravestones**

It was decided not to have a Council Lead for the burial ground. **ACTION: Cllr Jenkins** to advise Clerk on the required checks at the burial ground, including checks on the stability of memorials. **ACTION: Clerk** to discuss checking of the memorials with the Village Ranger.

**ACTION: Cllr Buchanan** to include trees and soft landscaping in the burial ground as part of his role as Parish Council Tree Lead.

**ACTION: Cllr Bellet** to liaise with the Commonwealth Graves Commission for the maintenance of all armed services personnel graves.
